1. INTRODUCTION

Centre for Materials for Electronics Technology (C-MET), Pune, a scientific society under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India, is a premier institution engaged in research, development, and technology transfer in the field of electronic materials and advanced manufacturing processes. CMET has been developing diamond-based materials systems for various applications in electronics and optoelectronics. The synthesis of single-crystalline diamond (SCD) wafers and crystals is a highly non-linear process, making effective process controls complicated. This has a detrimental impact on wafer quality and yield, and in turn increases costs.

For the purpose of this Expression of Interest (EOI), the term “Interested Industry Partner” shall mean any eligible Indian company, startup, MSME, or other legally registered entity that submits a response to this EOI for participation as a Development-cum-Production Partner (DcPP) with C-MET. Any reference in this document to “company”, “industry partner”, “vendor”, or “interested party” shall be construed to mean the “Interested Industry Partner”, unless the context requires otherwise.

Through this EOI, C-MET seeks to identify suitable industry partners interested in a joint project submission to develop a computer-implemented intelligent control system for diamond synthesis in a diamond synthesis machine. The proposed project intends to collaborate with interested industry partners who have expertise in the following domains:

- Multiphysics modelling and simulation application engineering & solver R&D
- Control board development for multi-AI agent architectures (e.g., Industrial Compute Modules, Apple Mac Mini, and similar platforms)
- AI/ML hardware platforms and embedded acceleration solutions
- AI/ML software development for industrial physics-based applications.
- Software development and application engineering
- System integration and process optimization/refinement.
- Fabrication, assembly, and commissioning of plasma-based diamond reactors
- This association will also focus on defining communication and control frameworks, including:
 - OPC Unified Architecture (OPC-UA)
 - MQTT (Message Queuing Telemetry Transport)
 - Legacy protocol support and interoperability
 - Sensor-based data acquisition and real-time processing using AI/ML algorithms
 - Control automation, system configuration, and reporting mechanisms

This initiative aims to build a scalable, intelligent, and industrial-grade control ecosystem to enhance precision, repeatability, and process efficiency in diamond synthesis operations.

In this context, C-MET Pune invites **Expression of Interest (EoI)** from qualified Indian entities (companies/Startups/MSMEs) to partner as **Interested Industrial Partners/ Development cum Production Partner (DePP)** for the **joint submission of a project towards the development of a computer-implemented method for controlling diamond synthesis in a diamond synthesis machine.**

The selected interested industry partner will collaborate with C-MET to design, develop, test, validate, and subsequently manufacture these advanced deposition systems for academic institutions, R&D laboratories, industries, and government organizations across India after obtaining non-exclusive ToT from C-MET.

This Expression of Interest is issued solely for the purpose of identifying potential industry partners for collaboration with C-MET. Submission of an EoI by any Interested Industry Partner shall not create any legally binding obligation on C-MET to enter into any partnership, agreement, or contractual arrangement. C-MET reserves the right to accept, reject, or cancel the EoI process at any stage without assigning any reason.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested Industry Partners must meet the following mandatory eligibility criteria:

2.1 General Eligibility Criteria

1. EoI is invited from eligible Indian entities acting as Interested Industry Partners, for the joint submission of a project towards the development of a computer-implemented method for controlling diamond synthesis in a diamond synthesis machine
2. The Interested Industry Partners should be a registered Indian company with relevant experience.
3. The Interested Industry Partners should have wide experience in the above-mentioned areas.
4. The details and supporting documents to prove the experience and capability in the areas mentioned should be provided along with the EoI.
5. The details required in Annexure I with supporting documents shall be submitted along with the letter of EoI
6. The Interested Industry Partner must not have been declared insolvent/ bankrupt or filed for insolvency/ bankruptcy or be in the process of being declared bankrupt before any designated authority.

7. The Interested Industry Partner should not have been blacklisted by any of the State/Central Government or organizations of the State/Central Government in India in the past three years.
8. The Interested Industry Partner should have a valid Registration Certificate, GST Registration Certificate, and PAN. Documentary evidence should be submitted.

2.2 Technical Qualification – Criteria for Interested Industry Partners

Interested Industry Partners may demonstrate capabilities under one or more of the following technical categories.

1. **Simulation Expertise:** Proven execution of at least **2 high-fidelity 3D multiphysics projects** (last 5 years) using coupled numerical solvers (CFD, particles, laser, multiphase, thermal, electromagnetics, etc)
2. **AI expertise: Proven execution of developing deep AI model architectures for at least 1 high-fidelity 3D Multiphysics project (last 5 years) using established AI platforms (TensorFlow, Keras, etc)**
3. **Workforce:** Permanent in-house team comprising PhD/Master's level Simulation Engineers and data science experts for complex industrial physics-based applications.

Hardware Development Companies / Entities –

1. **Process Standards: Must hold CMMI Level 3 (or higher) for Development/Services.**
2. **Quality & Security: Valid ISO 9001 (Quality) and ISO 27001 (Information Security) certifications are mandatory. ISO 42001 (AI Governance) is highly desirable.**
3. **AI & SCADA Integration: Track record of 3+ IT/OT convergence projects (last 5 years) integrating ML models with SCADA/PLC/DCS via OPC-UA or MQTT.**

Fabrication companies/ Entities –

1. Experience in assembling and fabricating microwave plasma-based reactors for diamond synthesis.

2.3 Disclaimer

1. This information is not intended to be exhaustive, and Interested Industrial Partners are required to make their own inquiries to submit the EoI. Submission of an EoI in response to this request for EoI shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the requirements and scope of the operational partner, if selected. Any clarification in this regard can be obtained from the contact person given in this notification inviting EoI.
2. C-MET reserves the right to cancel this EoI and/ or invite afresh with or without amendments, without liability or any obligation for such EoI and without assigning any reason. Information provided at this stage is indicative, and C-MET reserves the right to amend/add any further details in the EoI, as may be desired by the Competent Authority of C-MET and duly notified on its website.
3. C-MET further reserves the right to decline to discuss the EoI further with any party submitting an EoI.
4. C-MET will not be liable to pay/reimburse any cost/losses/expenses/penalties/damages of whatsoever nature to any person (s) / entity (ties) submitting the EoI.

3. EVALUATION PROCESS

- The EoIs received will be evaluated by a committee constituted by the competent authority of C-MET.
- Interested Industrial Partners will be shortlisted based on their experience and capability in the relevant field.

- The Committee will carry out discussions with the shortlisted proposers. The selection of the Interested Industrial Partners will be based on the selection criteria laid down by the committee.
- The decision of the committee on the selection of the operational partner will be final and binding.
 - A Memorandum of Understanding/Agreement and an NDA will be entered into with the selected proposer on sanction of the project by funding agencies.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

1. Background IPR of C-MET and the Interested Industry Partner shall remain with respective owners. Interested Industrial Partners must submit a list of their Background IPR at the EoI stage. Any undisclosed Background IPR cannot be claimed later
2. C-MET reserves the right to use the developed technology for academic research, training, and non-commercial purposes.
3. A detailed IPR sharing mechanism will be finalized in the Development Agreement (DA), subsequent to sanction of the project.
4. All intellectual property generated pursuant to the jointly executed project shall be jointly owned by C-MET and the selected Interested Industry Partner in proportions corresponding to their respective financial and/ or technical contributions to the project, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing between the parties.
5. Selected Interested Industry partner shall not publish or disclose any project results without the prior written approval of C-MET. The Parties shall provide at least ninety (90) days' prior written notice to each other before filing any patent applications arising from the project. 3. **Right to Accept/Reject:** C-MET reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EoI responses without assigning any reason thereof.
4. **Right to Modify:** C-MET reserves the right to change, vary, or withdraw any part of this EoI at any stage without any liability.
5. **No Financial Commitment:** This EoI is issued with no financial commitment at this stage. Commercial terms will be negotiated during the (Request for Proposal) RFP stage. This EoI does not constitute an offer, tender, or commitment to award any contract. C-MET reserves the absolute right to reject all responses, cancel the EoI process, modify requirements, or not proceed towards the RFP stage without assigning any reason and without any liability whatsoever.

6. **Relationship Disclaimer:** Nothing contained in this EoI shall be deemed to create any legal partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between C-MET and the Interested Industry Partner unless expressly set out in a subsequently executed agreement.
